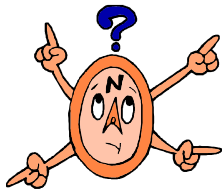

However, here are the things you need to know before arriving at your scheduled class:



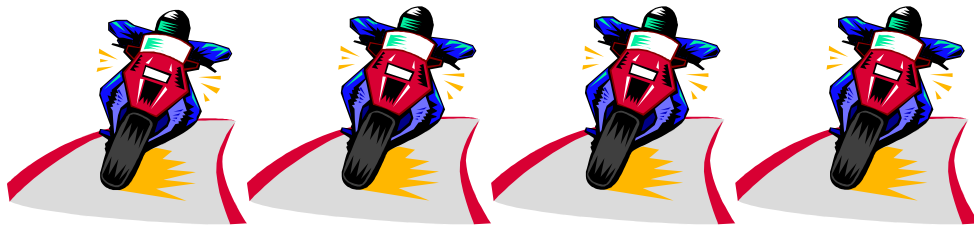
Please arrive by the scheduled time. Late comers cannot join in and catch up on material that has already been covered in the class.

- A.** You will need to take your current driver's license to the drivers' license office and have it converted to a new license (new picture) with the added motorcycle endorsement. There is a fee for the reprinting of the license, the endorsement, and a county tax.
